## Golden Circle Iceland's Treasure











The Golden Circle is Iceland's most iconic route, combining history, geology, and nature in a single day. From the historic Pingvellir National Park, where tectonic plates diverge, to the powerful Gullfoss waterfall and the geothermal activity of Geysir.

A must-do tour for every traveler, with additional stops at the Kerið crater and options to visit the Friðheimar tomato greenhouse.

## Places to Visit in the Golden Circle







 **Pick up at your accommodation.** Pick up at your hotel or nearest bus stop. Initial briefing, clothing recommendations, weather and safety information.

-  **Pingvellir National Park** Viewpoint overlooking Lake Pingvallavatn, history of the first parliament and walk between tectonic plates.
-  **Öxarárfoss Waterfall:** Descend along wooden walkways to experience the mist and take creative photos.
-  **Laugarvatn Geothermal Village:** Lake views, bread baked in volcanic sand, and the option of thermal baths.
-  **Gullfoss Waterfall:** Upper and lower balconies to admire the double drop and the glacial canyon.
-  **Encounter with Icelandic Horses:** Visit a local farm to learn about this beautiful breed.
-  **Geysir Geothermal Valley:** Circuit among fumaroles and the Strokkur geyser, which erupts every 8-10 minutes. Lunch featuring local options.
-  **Friðheimar Greenhouse:** A culinary experience surrounded by geothermal tomatoes.
-  **Kerið Crater and return to Reykjavík.** Entrance included to walk around the 3,000-year-old caldera or go down to the turquoise lake before returning to the capital.





### TOUR DETAILS

-  **Distance:** 300 km




### RECOMMENDATIONS

-  Follow the warning instructions




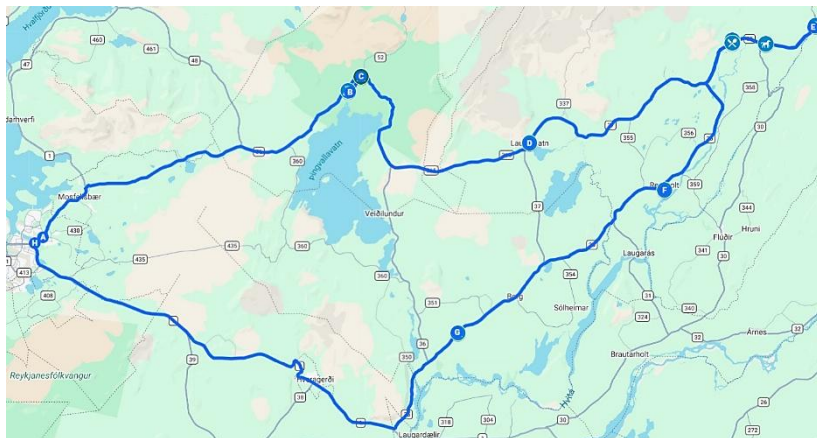
### FEATURED SEASONS

-  **Spring** (Apr–May): 0–10 °C, snowmelt, and powerful waterfalls.
-  **Summer** (Jun–Aug): 8–18 °C, midnight sun, lupine bloom.
-  **Autumn** (Sep–Oct): 2–10 °C, reddish hues, early auroras.
-  **Winter** (Nov–Mar): -8–2 °C, snow, ice in Kerið, and intense auroras.
