

Península of Reykjanes **Water and Fire**



Explore Iceland's geologically youngest region, a lunar landscape where the Mid-Atlantic Ridge rises from the ocean. Here you'll witness the earth's raw power: active geothermal areas, recent lava fields, and dramatic cliffs, with tours that include solidified lava from the most recent eruptions since 2023.

From the land bridge between two continents to the milky waters of the Blue Lagoon, this tour connects you with the primal forces that shaped the island.

Places to Visit in the **Península of Reykjanes**

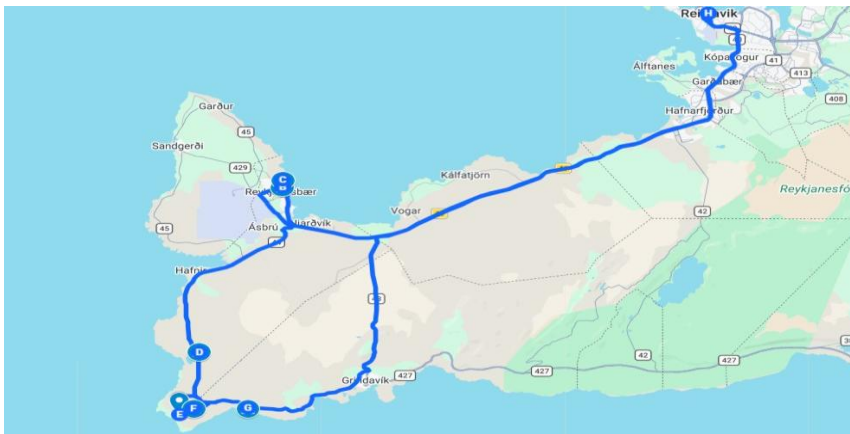
Pick up at your accommodation. Pick up at your hotel or nearest bus stop. Initial briefing, clothing recommendations, weather and safety information.

- Keflavík** – Coastal city with a musical history.
- Museum of Giant** – Folkloric attraction “Giganta en la Montaña”.
- Bridge of Two Continents** – Symbolic crossing between tectonic plates.
- Valahnúkamöl** – Cliffs battered by the Atlantic.
- Lighthouse of Reykjanes** – Iceland's oldest lighthouse, surrounded by volcanoes.
- Gunnhver** – Active geothermal area with fumaroles and legends.
- Brimketill** – Natural lava pool next to the ocean.
- Blue Lagoon** – Famous geothermal spa (optional entrance).
