## Península of Snæfellsnes **Iceland in Miniature**












Explore the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, often called "Iceland in Miniature" because it showcases nearly every type of Icelandic landscape in a single area. From the iconic Kirkjufell mountain (famous for Game of Thrones) to the towering Snæfellsjökull glacier (the setting for Jules Verne's Journey to the Center of the Earth), this region is a photographer's dream.

You'll witness dramatic coastal cliffs, golden and black sand beaches, charming fishing villages, and vast, moss-covered lava fields. Keep an eye out at Ytri Tunga beach, where colonies of seals often bask near the shore..

## Places to Visit in the Península of Snæfellsnes

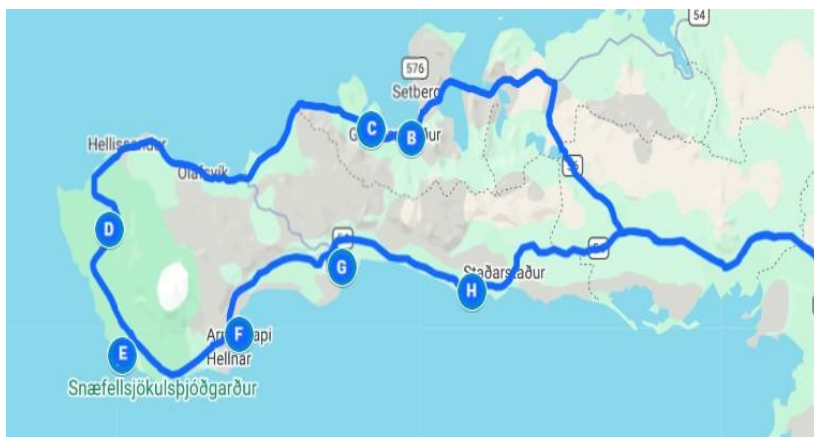
 **Pick up at your accommodation.** Pick up at your hotel or nearest bus stop. Initial briefing, clothing recommendations, weather and safety information.

-  **Stop in Borgarnes** – Rest, restrooms and snacks. (⌚ Stop approx. 20 min.)
-  **Grundarfoss Waterfall** – Nature and memorable photos. (⌚ Stop 30 min. approx.)
-  **Kirkjufell** – Most photographed mountain in Iceland. (⌚ Stop approx. 45 min.)
-  **Saxholt Crater** – Volcanic geology and panoramic views. (⌚ Stop approx. 30 min.)
-  **Djúpalónssandur Beach** – Black sand, lava, and shipwreck remains. (⌚ Stop approx. 30 min.)
-  **Arnarstapi** – Picturesque village with cliffs and local birds. (⌚ Stop approx. 90 min.)
-  **Búðakirkja (Black Church)** - Iconic spot for photos. (⌚ Stop 20 min. approx.)
-  **Ytri Tunga** – Beach with seal colonies. (⌚ 30 min stop if it's seal season)

 Return to Reykjavik – Final transfer of approx. 2 hours.
