## Places to visit on the South Coasts







 Pick up at your accommodation – Initial briefing on weather and safety.

-  **Rest stop** – Restrooms, snacks, or light breakfast.
  -  **Seljalandsfoss Waterfall** – Opportunity to walk behind the curtain of water.
  -  **Rutshellir Cave House** – Traditional Icelandic architecture.
  -  **Skógafoss Waterfall** – Impressive cascade with rainbows on sunny days.
  -  **Sólheimajökull Glacier** – Glacial tongue with ice formations.
  -  **Reynisfjara Beach** – Black sand, basalt columns, and lunch.
  -  **Vík í Mýrdal Village** – Local shops and souvenirs.
  -  **Return to Reykjavik** – Arrival in the late afternoon/evening.
- ★ **Optional extra:** Kvernufoss Waterfall (weather permitting).






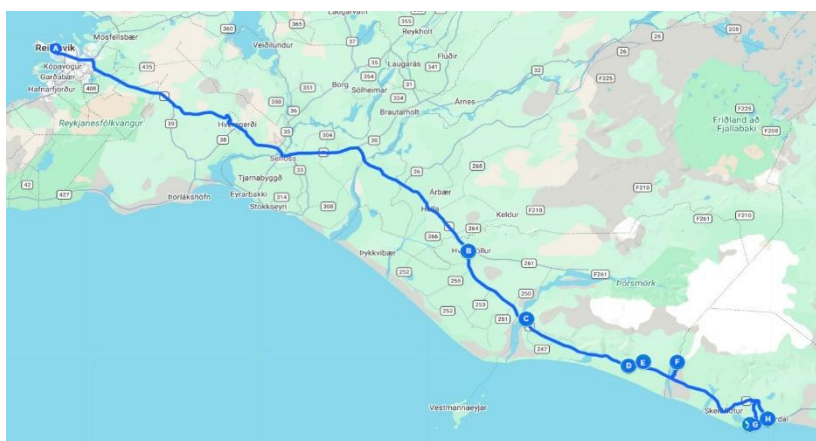
### FEATURED SEASONS

 **Spring** (Apr–May): 0–10 °C snowmelt, and cascading waterfalls.  
 **Summer** (Jun–Aug): 8–18 °C, midnight sun, verdant fields, and puffins in Dyrhólaey.  
 **Autumn** (Sep–Oct): 2–10 °C reddish hues, early auroras, fewer tourists.  
 **Winter** (Nov–Mar): -8–2 °C, snow, ice on waterfalls, and a chance of the Northern Lights.
